



**Sub: Clarification of existence of DoT Policy for Preference to domestically manufactured telecom products in procurement-reg.**

The undersigned is directed to say that Department of Telecommunication had issued a policy notification No 18-07/2010-IP dated 05.10.2012 for giving preference to domestically manufactured telecom Production in Public Procurement. Another notification was issued on 11.01.2017 on the value addition criterion. As per the clause 19 of the Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion (DIPP) order No P-45021/2/2017-PP(BE-II) dated 28.05.2018, the Department of Telecommunications is in process to review the existing DoT PMA policy dated 05.10.2012 & 11.01.2017. Till the issuance of revised Policy by this Department, the existing DoT PMA policy dated 05.10.2012 (the PMA and VA of year 2017-2018 are applicable until revised subsequently) and notification dated 11.01.2017 still in force and will be applicable with DIPP order.
