



All India Revenue and ARPU Trend




- The private GSM Mobile Operators recorded a revenue of INR 214 billion in the third quarter of year 2013
- The QoQ revenue for private GSM Mobile Operators has decreased by 1.6%
- The private GSM Mobile Operators recorded ARPU of INR 126
- The ARPU levels decreased by 3.2% q-o-q

Circles Ranked in terms of AGR




ARPU Trend for Metros




- Kolkata and Chennai witnessed an increase in ARPU level while Delhi and Mumbai recorded a fall in ARPU
- Mumbai has constantly registered the highest ARPU value and stood at INR 193
- Mumbai also registered the highest Q-o-Q decline in ARPU of 2.33%
- Kolkata registered the highest Q-o-Q growth in ARPU (INR 128) of 1.89%

ARPU Trend for Category A Circles




- All the Category A circles witnessed a decline in ARPU levels
- ARPU in Gujarat (INR 115) saw the maximum decrease of 5.77%.
- Karnataka was the highest ARPU generating circle among category A circles.

ARPU Trend for Category B Circles



- All the Category B circles except Kerala witnessed a decrease in ARPU levels
- MP witnessed maximum decrease in ARPU (INR 98) in the third quarter of 7.97%
- Kerala has the highest ARPU of INR 187 followed by Punjab (INR 147) among B circles.

ARPU Trend for Category C Circles



- All the Category C circles witnessed a decrease in ARPU levels
- Assam witnessed maximum decrease in ARPU (INR 128) of 5.24%.
- J&K has the highest ARPU of INR 160
